

# 1. Pre Course Email

Dear Parent/Guardian

We believe that being able to confidently ride a bike on the roads is an important life skill for our pupils. To help our pupils develop the skills needed to do so, we have arranged for an instructor from [Little Riders](#) to deliver a **Bikeability Level 1 & 2** course for our Year 6 pupils.

The **7 hour course** is part of the national [Bikeability cycle training programme](#) and funded by the government via Norfolk County Council.

The course is for pupils who can already ride a bike confidently who would like to learn how to ride safely on the road. It will take place on the school playground and on local roads during the school day on **Monday 20th (PM)** and Tuesday **21st April (AM)**

During the course, your child will take part in a series of fun activities which will develop a range of skills, including;

- Stop and start
- Pass stationary vehicles
- Understand the road
- Negotiate the road
- Share the road

Your child will need a bike and helmet for the session. If they don't have their own bike or helmet, Little Riders have a small amount that they can lend pupils.

If your child already has their own bike, please could we ask that you;

- Check that your child's bike is in good working order prior to the first session ([Watch video showing how to check a bike is safe to use](#))
- Also, please remove any baskets, doll seats etc as these will only get in the way and add weight to your child's bike,
